**Tour Description** This is a great ride through Missouri and Arkansas to participate in the Bike, Blues and BBQ Motorcycle Rally in Fayette Arkansas. We will leave the Chicago area on Saturday and ride along the Illinois and Mississippi Rivers. We will ride through the Ozarks in Missouri and continue riding the Ozarks into Arkansas. While we only spend 2 days in Fayetteville at the rally, we use the rest of the week to ride some incredible roads. I have always believed the best roads for motorcycle riding were in the mountains of the west. While the roads in the west may be better than the roads in Arkansas, these roads were made for motorcycle riding and are much closer to get to. As with all our tours we do all the work planning and preparing so you can have a great time.

- Day 0 – Depart the Chicago Area for Hannibal Missouri
- Day 1 – Hannibal Missouri to Mountain View Arkansas
- Day 2 – Mountain View to Hot Springs Arkansas
- Day 3 – Hot Springs Area Day Ride
- Day 4 – Hot Springs to Eureka Springs (via RT 7)
- Day 5 – Eureka Springs to Fayetteville (Bikes Blues and BBQ)
- Day 6 - Eureka Springs to Fayetteville (Bikes Blues and BBQ)
- Day 7 – Eureka Springs to Washington Missouri
- Day 8 – Washington Missouri to Home
