Tour Description

We arrive in Las Vegas on Saturday afternoon and spend our first night at a hotel/Casino. After checking into our hotel we will pick up our motorcycles and get them ready for the road trip. Once the motorcycles are ready we will hold a safety briefing to cover how we are going to ride, and where and what we will see during the riding day. Time permitting; we will head south to the Hoover Dam. It is an amazing feat of engineering and construction.



Day 2 – Sunday - After a “peaceful night’s” sleep in LV we will meet for breakfast and a briefly discuss the day’s ride. We will head north through the Valley of Fire State Park. We will continue northeast and spend the night in the Le Verkin, Utah area after a very enjoyable 185 mile ride.

Day 3 – Monday - “Kick Stands Up” (KSU) at 9:00 AM and we will ride approximately 200 miles through some of the most beautiful scenery in the world! We will ride in Zion National Park, Bryce Canyon and mountainous national forest roads. This will be a “short day” for riding but long on amazing sights. It will still be a full day since we will need to make many stops just to take photos. We will spend the evening near Torrey, Utah.



Day 4 – Tuesday - KSU at 9:00 AM and our first stop is Capitol Reef National Park. We will ride through Glen Canyon National Recreation Area and Natural Bridges National Monument. This is our longest riding day but we ride through some long uninterrupted stretches of road with amazing scenery. We will have picnic lunch near the Colorado River. We will spend two night in Cortez, Colorado.

Day 5 – Wednesday - KSU at 9:00 am and we will head east to Mesa Verde National Park to see the Ancient Cliff Dwellings. If you are not into Ancient Cliff Dwelling we will ride the Million Dollar Highway up to Ouray and back; a 250 miles day on one of the most amazing roads in the country.

Day 6 - Thursday - KSU at 9:00 AM and our first stop is the 4-Corners National Monument. This is the only place in the US were you can be in 4 states all at the same time. Most of the day will be spent riding through the Navajo Indian Reservation. We will ride through Monument Valley. While you may not recognize the name, you will recognize it from the very unique rock formations. We will spend the evening in the Page, Arizona area.



Day 7 – Friday - KSU at 9:00 AM as we head south and west where we will spend much of our day at the South Rim of the Grand Canyon. Make sure your camera batteries are fully charged and you have plenty of space on your memory sticks. The Grand Canyon is an amazing place that needs very little introduction. We will spend the night in Williams, Arizona.

Day 8 – Saturday - the last day of our road trip starts with KSU at 9:00 AM as we head west out of Williams. Just west of Ashe Fork we will ride on one of the longest stretches of the original Route 66. We will continue on Route 66 through Kingman, Az. and over the new Hoover Dam Bridge, eventually arriving that evening in Las Vegas. We will load the motorcycles on the trailer Saturday evening or Sunday morning. This is our last night to have fun in Las Vegas! Talk to me if you want to stay in LV additional nights.



Day 9 – Sunday - A short trip to the airport and you fly home. This tour is the best riding tours we offer. The roads and the sights along the way are truly amazing. This tour is our most popular and for this tour with have increased the amount of riders because of the remote areas we will be riding, space is limited to 20 bikes.
